

South End Neighborhood Council Application For Board Membership

Thank you for your interest in applying for a position on the SENCo Board! You are eligible to run for a position on the Board if you live in the South End Neighborhood Council Boundaries, you are at least 18 years of age, and the Board has an opening. You are a member of the South End Neighborhood Council if you live, work, or own a business or property within the South End Neighborhood Council's boundaries. The South End Neighborhood Council boundaries are from I-5 in the north, I-5 to the west, Pacific Ave south to 72nd, east to McKinley Ave, and south to 96th, 96th being the Council's southernmost boundary. The South End Neighborhood Council has an 11-member board. Board members are elected for a standard 2-year term, except under special circumstances where an election is held to fill a position on the board for the duration of a vacated seat. This Board elects the 5-member Executive Board for the following 2-year positions: Chair, Vice Chair, Correspondence Secretary, Recording Secretary, and Treasurer. Board members may hold the position as long as they are re-elected and no more than 60% of the Board are elected in any one year.
