You are a member of the South End Neighborhood Council if you live, work, or own a business or property within the South End Neighborhood Council's boundaries. You are eligible to run for a position on the Board if you live in the South End Neighborhood Council boundaries, are at least 18 years of age, and the Board has an opening. The South End Neighborhood Council boundaries are: I-5 to the north, I-5 to the west, Pacific Ave south to 72nd, east to McKinley Ave, and south to 96th, as 96th is the Council's southernmost boundary. This Board elects the 5-member Executive Board for the following 2-year positions: Chair, Vice Chair, Correspondence Secretary, Recording Secretary, and Treasurer. Board members may hold the position as long as they are re-elected. No more than 60% of the Board are elected in any one year.
